

# Handprint Falling Leaves

Children love to see their handprints on paper and they love to make their own handprints using stamp pads and paint. This is an easy project for younger children who can't use scissors yet.

## Supplies Needed:

- Plain construction paper
- Brown construction paper
- Glue stick
- Red, orange, yellow, brown paint or stamp pads

## Directions:

- Provide the child with a pre-cut shape of a trunk and branches
- Help the child glue the trunk to the plain construction paper
- Press the child's hand lightly in paint or on a stamp pad, then make handprint leaves to fill in around the branches and place some leaves on the ground
