

Native American Shaker



Supplies You Will Need:

- 2 small paper plates
- Dried beans, dried pasta, dried rice, or popcorn kernels
- Stapler
- Hole punch
- Feathers
- Black crayon or black marker
- Yarn or twine
- Blunt scissors
- Glue

Directions for Native American Shaker:

1. Place the dried product (beans, pasta, rice, popcorn kernels) on the plate in the center.
2. Invert the other plate over top of the bottom plate and secure together with staples.
3. Punch 2 holes, one on each side. Then, tie a piece of yarn or twine through each hole.
4. Draw some Native American symbols on the top of the plate.
5. Cut out the animal pictures and glue them to the top of the paper plate shaker.
6. Glue feathers around the edge of the paper plate shaker.
